## To make these designs:

1. Simply unscrew the top of the pen, add the desired large-hole beads of your choice and screw the top back on! (See the diagram on the back.)


TIP: The mandrel (rod) has a top and a bottom. The end with more threads is the top. Make sure you screw the end with fewer threads into the base of the pen. Screwing the mandrel in upside down will cause the pen to not function properly.
