Tools: chain-nose pliers, wire cutters, 12" ruler, Mini Bead Stoppers™ (#69-143-08)


To make this design:

- 1. Lay each half of the leather cuff ends on the ruler. For an 8" bracelet, place the center of the snap of one cuff end on the 8" mark on the ruler and the center of the snap of the other cuff end on the 0" mark.
- 2. Lay the crystal square link on the ruler so that the center of the crystal is over the 4" mark on the ruler.
- **3.** Lay each 3-strand square spacer bar on the ruler so they are equal distance from the crystal square link and edges of the cuff ends.
- **4.** Lay two of the 3-strand flower spacers so that they are equal distance from the 3-strand square spacer boxes and edge of cuff ends.

HINT: You may want to mark each of these measurements on a sheet of paper as a guide. Drawing the shapes of the components onto this paper guide is helpful as well.

NOTE: This next portion of the design is constructed from the center out towards the cuff ends.

- 5. Cut six pieces of Beadalon, each approximately 6" long.
- 6. String approximately 15 beads from the bead cocktail mix onto one of the pieces of Beadalon. Center the beads on the Beadalon and gently fold this in half around the crystal square link, then thread both ends through a seed bead and the center hole of a 3-strand flower spacer.
- 7. Continue adding approximately ½" of cocktail mix beads onto the now doubled strand of Beadalon.
- 8. Thread the doubled strand of Beadalon through the center hole of the 3-strand square spacer bar. Add a seed bead and a crimp bead (your crimp will be hidden behind the 3-strand square spacer). (See picture #1.)
- 9. Secure the Beadalon in place with a bead stopper.
- **10.** Repeat steps 6-9 two more times, threading the Beadalon through the remaining 2 holes of the 3-strand flower spacer and the 3-strand square spacer bar.



- **11.** Repeat steps 6-10 on the opposite side of the crystal square link.
- 12. Make sure your sections are even, and make any necessary adjustments before crimping. Remove the bead stopper from the center strand, and crimp with flat nose pliers and cut excess Beadalon. Repeat this step for both outside strands. Repeat again for three strands on the opposite side of the square crystal ring.

NOTE: This next portion of the design is constructed from cuff ends toward the center.

- **13.** Cut six pieces of Beadalon, each approximately 6" long.
- **14.** Add one Wire Guardian to each hole of the leather cuff ends.
- **15.** Thread one piece of Beadalon through the center Wire Guardian on one of the cuff ends.
- **16.** Gently fold the Beadalon in half and add approximately ½" of cocktail mix beads onto this doubled strand of Beadalon. Thread the Beadalon through the center hole of the 3-strand flower spacer.
- **17.** Add another ½" of cocktail mix beads onto this doubled strand of Beadalon.
- **18.** Secure the remaining Beadalon with a bead stopper. (See picture #2.)
- **19.** Repeat steps 14-18 two more times, threading the Beadalon through the outer Wire Guardians and the outside holes of the 3-strand flower spacers.
- **20.** Remove the center bead stopper, and thread the doubled strand of Beadalon through the empty center hole of the 3-strand square spacer bar.
- **21.** Add one seed bead and one crimp bead. Crimp, and trim excess Beadalon.
- 22. Repeat steps 20 & 21 for the two remaining strands, threading them through the corresponding holes of the 3-strand square spacer bar.
- 23. Repeat steps 15-22 for the other side.
