

# "Beaded Bloom" Bag

## Suggested Materials:

<u>Qty.</u>	<u>Stock #</u>	<u>Name</u>
1 vial	20-228-502	Size 11 Toho® Japanese glass seed beads, garnet metallic
1 vial	20-228-451	Size 11 Toho Japanese glass seed beads, green metallic
1 vial	20-228-461	Size 11 Toho Japanese glass seed beads, purple metallic
40	23-397-172	7mm thin Czech glass flower bead caps, rose
13	23-397-242	7mm thin Czech glass flower bead caps, garnet
22	23-397-362	7mm thin Czech glass flower bead caps, green opal
1 spool	61-536-25	0.006" (0.15mm) DandyLine™ cord, white
1	63-251-01	4x3" organza bag, white

**Tools:** scissors, thread conditioner such as beeswax (#69-022) or Thread Heaven® (#69-023), Size 10 beading needle (#65-000-10), bead nabber (#65-090)

## To make this design:

1. Condition a 2-3 foot piece of cord with beeswax or Thread Heaven.
2. Add a needle, thread though from the inside of the bag and make a knot at the end.
3. Sew on seed beads and flower beads, in random colors and quantity, securing periodically with a backstitch.
4. Continue adding beads until bag is covered or looks pleasing to the eye.
5. Cut additional pieces of thread as needed.

**TIP:** Use a bead nabber to help pick up beads, as well as protect your fingers.
