Suggested Materials:

<u>Qty.</u>	<u>Stock #</u>	<u>Name</u>
1	55-401-4	Round wire bookmark, gold plate
1	49-601-20	2" dog tag, brass
2	37-178-2	10mm round jump rings, yellow (not pictured)
3		Glueable gems (available at local craft stores)
1		Paper image of your choice

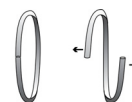
Tools: flat-nose pliers, scissors, stiff bristle paint brush, adhesive such as Crafter's Pick™ The Ultimate (#60-280), dimensional glaze (such as JudiKins© Diamond Glaze™)

To make this design:

1. Cut out paper image and glue onto flat surface of dog tag with adhesive.
2. Attach flat-back gems with adhesive.
3. To seal, brush on dimensional glaze.
4. Use jump rings to attach finished dog tag to bookmark after it has dried.

Jump-ring hint:

When you open and close jump rings, twist sideways instead of "ovalling" them. This keeps their shape better, which makes them easier to close all the way.

Don't pull apart sideways

DESIGN OPTION: Create your own custom jump rings, like those pictured above.

Tools: pin vise (#69-040), clamp, jump-ring maker (#69-200)

Suggested Materials:

Stock #	Name
47-208-SP	20-gauge round wire, red brass
46-704-11	24-gauge ColourCraft® wire, copper
46-704-20	24-gauge ColourCraft wire, gold
46-704-14	24-gauge ColourCraft wire, silver
47-208-SP	20-gauge round wire, red brass

1. Use a pin vise and clamp to twist three different color strands of 24-gauge wire.
2. Create a 10mm three-color twisted jump rings using a jump-ring making tool.
3. Repeat steps 1 & 2 for making a two-strand 10mm jump ring using 20-gauge wire.
