

"Bejeweled Hoopla" Earrings

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Suggested Materials:

94	05-301-03-49	3mm Swarovski® crystal bicones, light azure
8 ft	64-592	Dead-soft 26-gauge round wire, sterling silver
1 pr	54-552-50	50mm hoop earrings, sterling silver

Color Option 2

32	05-301-03-150	3mm Swarovski crystal bicones, crystal/golden shadow
32	05-301-03-13	3mm Swarovski crystal bicones, fuchsia
32	05-301-03-144	3mm Swarovski crystal bicones, khaki
8 ft	64-592	Dead-soft 26-gauge round wire, sterling
1 pr	54-552-50	50mm hoop earrings, sterling silver

Tools: flat-nose pliers, cutters

To make this design:

1. Cut a 4-foot section of wire.
2. Leaving a 1" tail, wrap the wire securely around the hoop 2 times.
3. Add a crystal bicone to the long end and line it up on the outside edge of the hoop. Wrap the wire around 2 more times then add another crystal.
4. Repeat step 3 until the entire hoop is covered with crystals, leaving a few millimeters bare.
Or, just wire wrap to the catch on the hoop, making sure the catch is able to close all the way.
5. Add additional wraps at each end if needed and cut excess wire.
6. Repeat for the 2nd earring.

Tips: Wrapping the wire will be easier if you open the catch on the earring first.
This gauge of wire is easy to manipulate with your fingers, but you may need to use pliers to tighten the first and final wraps.
