10	#05-000-03-02	3mm SWAROVSKI ELEMENTS round crystal beads, crystal/aurora borealis
2	#05-708-3-01	8mm SWAROVSKI ELEMENTS rhinestone wheel beads, silver plate crystal
22	#49-947-33-AS	4mm TierraCast rococo square bead, antiqued silver
8	#28-333-55-08	14mm lampwork glass rondelle beads, pink

### Tools and supplies:

side cutter (#69-273-05)  
crimping pliers (#65-010)  
Bead Fix™ adhesive (#60-242)

### TIPS:

- Add a crimp bead to one end of the stringing cable. Optional: Add a dab of adhesive before adding the crimp cover.
- Add the cross bar and string the beads as pictured. The cross bar acts as the “T” of the toggle clasp.
