### Suggested Materials:

1	21-340-28-185	3" floral 2-hole gemstone collar pendant, black lip shell
17	05-328-04-09	CRYSTALLIZED™ 4mm bicone crystals, light amethyst
17	05-328-04-75*	CRYSTALLIZED™ 4mm bicone crystals, black diamond/aurora borealis
17	05-328-04-103*	CRYSTALLIZED™ 4mm bicone crystals, chrysolite/aurora borealis
17	05-328-04-167*	CRYSTALLIZED™ 4mm bicone crystals, rosaline/aurora borealis
17	05-328-04-175*	CRYSTALLIZED™ 4mm bicone crystals, rose water opal
17	05-328-04-178*	CRYSTALLIZED™ 4mm bicone crystals, light gray opal
30'	61-210-10-00	10lb. test hemp cord assortment, black
1	44-940-49-AS	TierraCast® hibiscus charm, antiqued silver plate

\* **NOTE:** Beginning in 2009, Swarovski is replacing their 5301 faceted bicone crystal style with their new 5328 faceted XILION bicone bead. Either style of bicone works well for this design.

**Tools and supplies:** scissors, white glue, size E crochet hook (or one that produces a loose stitch)

### To make this design:

1. Cut the hemp cord into six 5' pieces.
2. Mix all the colors of bicones together and string 17 beads onto each piece of cord.

**TIP:** Stiffen the end of the cord with a dab of white glue so it doesn't fray.

3. Crochet six strands of approximately the same length, placing a crystal every 2 or 3 stitches, leaving 3-4" tails.
4. Stitch the charm onto one strand. Connect it to 2 other strands, loosely braid, then knot to the shell collar.
5. Stitch a chain loop on the end of one to create the closure. Connect it to 2 other strands, loosely braid, and then knot to the shell collar on the other side.
