4. Make Bodice \& Arms:
a. On one wire string both Shell Beads. Make sure smaller ends of each bead are facing out. Bring them to the front of the project and pull the other wire through the opposite end. Shells should now be secure in the front to make Bodice.
b. Cut a piece of Wire approx. 11". Pull wire through the top row of ivory beads (Row 42). There should be two wires on each side for the arms.

c. Choose an arm and string 1 ivory bead. Pull opposite wire through. Pull tight so bead sits close to body.
d. Continue down the arm with:

5 rows of 3 ivory beads
7 rows of 2 ivory beads
2 rows of 3 ivory beads
2 rows of 2 ivory beads

e. Tie off wire like in step 2d, by twisting wire behind the last 2 Trim $\quad 8888$ Knot 2888 beads.

b. Continue stringing rows up using:

Row 43- 3 ivory beads
Row 44- 2 ivory beads
Row 45- 3 ivory beads
Row 46- 4 ivory beads
Row 47- 2 ivory, 1 Red (for the mouth), and 2 ivory
Row 48- 6 ivory
Row 49- 1 ivory, 1 Blue (for the eyes), 2 ivory, 1 Blue, and 1 ivory
Row 50- 5 ivory
Row 51- 4 Hair colored
c. Continue to string hair-colored beads on each remaining wire. Create any desired length. Leave enough wire at end to pull back up through about 4 beads, skipping the very last bead. Pull snug and trim excess wire. Continue on the other wire.
d. Cut 9 pieces of wire each approx. 8". Pull one through the 50th row, making sure there is an equal length on each side. String beads.
NOTE: At any time during the making of the Hair, string in the flower beads. Any other added beads can go in as well for decoration!
e. String another wire through rows $49,48,47 \& 46$. String Hair.
f. On the top row of hair- \#51, attach 3 more wires by twisting them in place in between beads. Put a wire between the 1 st $\& 2$ nd bead, the 2 nd $\& 3$ rd, and the 3 rd \& 4 th. Find the middle of wire and gently twist once so that each piece stays in place, for a total of 6 strands of hair.

a. Cut a piece of Wire approx. $16^{\prime \prime}$ for the head. On the top row, behind the bodice, attach wire. Find the center and wrap wire once between the 4th $\&$ the 5 th bead and then again between the 7 th $\& 8$ th bead. Be sure to keep each end equal length.
f. Finish opposite arm. Gently form arms in desired pose.
 Bead wire and finish off ends. Form hair as desired.
Leave straight or put a little curl in it by twisting around a pencil or awl.
